relevance within the engineering field and industrial society premiering the new series the present book by dieter altenpohl gives the reader a very general outlook in fact a position analysis of materials and the materials industry within the framework of our contemporary technological environment it ventures moreover to forecast the changes affecting this pattern in a dynamic interdependent world this may be an unusual way to start a scientific series it is believed nevertheless to be an appropriate one
